

2nd Coordination Meeting SportAccord in February 2010

2nd Coordination Meeting, Beijing SportAccord concluded 2009 with the 2nd Coordination meeting in Beijing. The Beijing Organising Committee presented a progress report. Work is in progress and on schedule for ceremonies, publications, TV packages, transport, accreditation and other event services. 2010 Combat Games sport disciplines and categories confirmed Fact and figures: 1084 athletes, the higher ranked men and women from 5 continents 26 disciplines 134 categories.

WADA Code Signatory SportAccord became WADA code-signatory as event organisers. SportAccord and the Beijing Organising Committee will work together during the event to carry out anti-doping controls according to the World Anti-doping code and standards. The preliminary anti-doping test distribution plan was completed and will be further defined in collaboration with each IF within the next couple of months.

Event's Hotel allocation The three following event hotels were confirmed:

Xiyuan Hotel Referees Hotel Friendship Hotel Athletes Hotel Intercontinental Beichen Headquarter Hotel The Friendship hotel will host all the athletes from the 13 sports, enhancing the Martial Arts and Combat sports sense of community of the event. All referees will be accommodated in the Xiyuan Hotel. Both hotels are located within short distance of the sport infrastructures. The Intercontinental Beichen Hotel will become for the length of the event the main operations centre.
